Panel Session

A group of 3-5 presenters who collaborate in advance of the conference will present multiple perspectives on a topic relevant to the conference theme.

Paper Presentation

Presenting (not reading) a paper you have written relevant to the conference theme. Your submission may be put alongside other papers with similar themes to be presented during the same session.

Performance Arts

Performances of theater, music, readings of fiction or poetry, or other performance pieces relevant to the conference theme.

Plenary

While the UALE Executive Board is responsible for the 2-3 plenary sessions that happen during the conference, we invite proposals for plenary sessions.

Poster/Display/Visual Arts

Multi-media pieces on the conference theme will be on exhibit. They may not be presented in a specific session, but will be displayed throughout the conference. Electronic arts are welcome; however, the producer must provide the technology needed for the display.

Roundtable Discussion

One or two facilitators moderate a discussion on a topic or issue relevant to the conference theme. This does not include formal presentations, but may include structured discussion activities like small group work.

Teaching Demonstration

A hands-on, interactive demonstration of curriculum that offers copies of materials.

Video Showing

Propose to have the screening of a video built into the conference program. Ideally these videos would be a maximum of 60 minutes long.
