

Application Form for 2013 UALE Research Awards

Revised Application Deadline: December 2, 2013

UALE is pleased to continue awarding grants to fund research related to workers, unions, and employment policy. Preference will be given to UALE members in determining award recipients. UALE has allocated \$5,000 for this purpose. We will select a maximum of **two** award recipients.

A subcommittee comprised of three UALE executive board members (one union, one university, one community-based) will review applications and make a recommendation to the entire UALE board, which will have final approval.

Applications for the 2013 awards are due by December 2, 2013. The recipients will be announced by December 15, 2013. The total number of awards for 2013 will be determined by the UALE executive board.

UALE requests that successful applicants present the results of their research at a UALE conference.

Required Elements for Application

I. Cover Letter

- One page overview of project and budget request

II. Review of Project (3-5 pages)

- Rationale for Project
- Description of Work to be Done
- Significance and Outcomes
- Timetable for Completion
- Plans for Dissemination/Use of Research

III. Key Personnel

- Please list names of key personnel involved in project (including, where applicable, participating organizations or groups)
- Qualifications of key personnel (attach resumes or vitas for all key personnel)
- Explain roles that each person will have in the project

IV. Budget

- Include itemized budget (e.g., salary buyout for time spent on project, stipends, travel, telephone costs, transcription) that outlines how funds will be used
- List other potential funding sources for the project
